Emerging Workforce Trend: Blue Collar AI

Al and cybersecurity have the largest talent gaps in ICT. Aaron Burciaga, Vice President of Analytics and Artificial Intelligence for ECS, presented his findings on the need for a Blue Collar AI workforce. There is growing demand for data farmers (data creation), data miners (data collection), and data welders (data organization and presentation) who support data architects and scientists. Blue Collar AI skills can be developed in community college career education with pathways to 4-year programs.

The BACCC was introduced to intel's AI for Future Workforce Program by faculty at Foothill College, designed for students from employability education institutions (e.g. Community Colleges, Vocational schools). The program offers institutions 3 proogressive modules of curriculum:

- Appetizer: Courses that introduce non-technical and technical students to AI across all disciplines
- Electives: Courses to implement Into existing IT/Computer Science or equivalent curriculum
- Core: Al Associate Degree

Exploration into implementation of the Intel program at Bay Area colleges is underway.
